- d) Drainage
  - i) The drain repair at Del Valle and Georgine was presented. The residents requested the work to be expedited, we acknowledged their concern and will request the contractor to expedite the repair.
- e) Curve Signage

The residents at 4370 Sleeping Indian Rd, reported that there had been three accidents into their property because of drivers taking the curve at excessive speed. The noted that in the 20 years they have lived there, 10 similar incidents have occurred.

- f) New Speed sign report
  - i) The new speed sign was presented to the residents, and it was described as: The main purpose of digital speed signs is to influence driver behavior and reduce speeding. Having a sign clearly visible near roads can remind drivers that they should not exceed the posted speed limit, helping them make informed decisions while driving. It is also mobile and can be posted in different areas of concern. It also collects speed and traffic volume data.
